ASSE seeks industry professionals to participate in the creation of the Series 13000, *Professional Qualifications Standard for Service Plumbing*

Westlake, Ohio, Feb. 16, 2012 — The American Society of Sanitary Engineering (ASSE) is forming a working group for the creation of the ASSE Series 13000, *Professional Qualifications Standard for Service Plumbing*. The initial draft of this Standard is complete and ASSE is currently seeking working group members with interest in developing this Professional Qualifications Standard.

The ASSE Series 13000 will apply to individuals who maintain and service plumbing systems. The purpose of this Standard is to provide minimum performance criteria, identified by industry consensus, for service plumbing and will apply only to service and maintenance plumbing.

The first working group meeting is set for April 19, 2012. All interested parties, especially those involved in service and maintenance plumbing, are invited to participate. To become a member of this working group, interested parties must submit an application.
