ASSE asks industry professionals to participate in the creation of the Series 15000, Fire Sprinkler Systems Professional Qualifications Standard

Westlake, Ohio, August 4, 2010 — The American Society of Sanitary Engineering is forming a working group for the creation of the ASSE Series 15000, Fire Sprinkler Systems Professional Qualifications Standard. The working group, which will be chaired by Dan Driebel of Road Sprinkler Fitters Local 669, is being formed in order to create a new professional qualifications standard for individuals who are involved in the testing, repair and maintenance of fire sprinkler systems.
